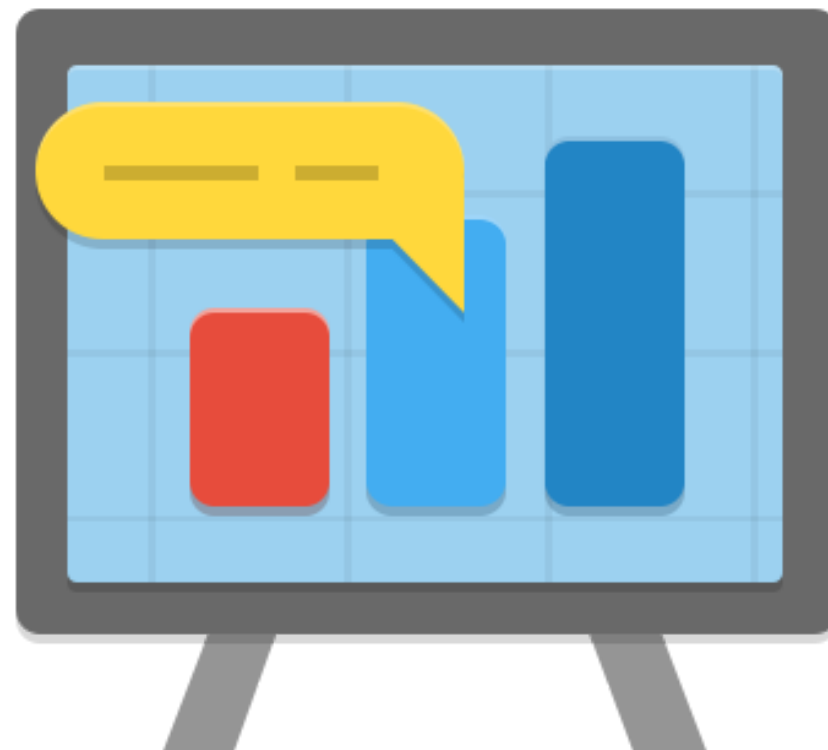

Christine Lewis, Head of the Indonesia/Switzerland Desk in the OECD's Economics Department, will present findings from the latest Economic Survey of Indonesia. The report takes stock of Indonesia's economy and medium-term challenges. Steady economic growth, with help from government policies, has raised incomes and lowered poverty rates. The report discusses ways of increasing Indonesia's external resilience and increasing the dividend from Indonesia's favourable demographics. Given that spending on infrastructure, health and social protection remains constrained by low revenues, the report considers ways of raising revenues in a growth- and equity-friendly way. Finally, it highlights the potential of the tourism sector to diversify Indonesia's economy and boost regional development, with the right policies to ensure its sustainability.
